<p>Sentences! Write a sentence for each of your words. Be sure to underline each word in the sentence.</p> 	<p>Crazy Story! Write a story or paragraph using at least 10 words of the week!</p> 	<p>ABC Order! List your words of the week in alphabetical order.</p> 
<p>Blind Writing Sort! The student writes the headings across the top of a page of their WSNB. A family member reads a word from the sort to the student. Then, without looking, the student has to write the word under the correct category. After it is written, the family member should check to make sure that the word is spelled correctly and written under the correct heading.</p> 	<p>Word Search!
